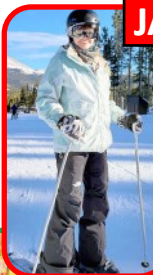


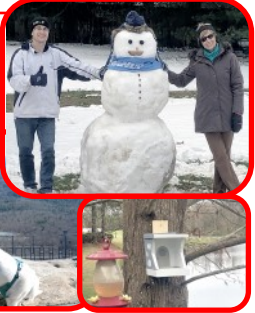

FEB

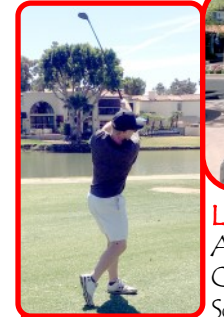

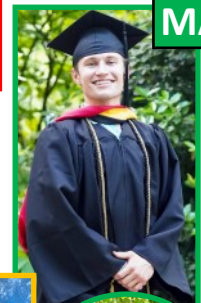

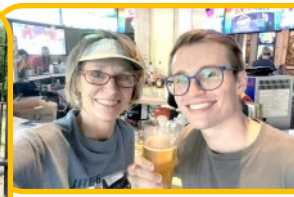


MAY

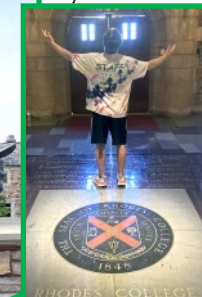
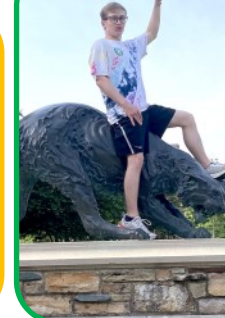
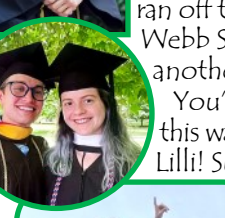


You're probably wondering what this waterfall of fruit masterpiece is? Lilli! Such an artist! She created this "cake" for her boyfriend Taylor's birthday!



JUN

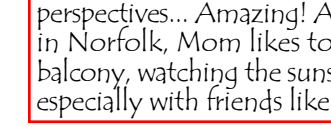
